Dear Potential Journey Participant:

As many of you know we cancelled the Holy Week in Rome trip that was scheduled for April 20, 2011. Father DiOrio was to be the Spiritual Director. The trip was cancelled because Father Ralph felt that his medical condition, at the time, would limit his ability to fully interact with the group participants. His condition has improved to the point that he is back jumping up onto a 5 foot stage during his recent out-reach service in Dubois, Pennsylvania in January of this year. He is maintaining a full schedule of healing services for 2011 at St Anne's Shrine in Sturbridge, MA.

We have arranged a Paris and Lourdes pilgrimage for September 13, through September 22, 2011 with Father DiOrio as the Spiritual Director. (Refer to attached flyer/brochure). The trip includes four nights in Paris and four nights in Lourdes, France. While in Paris we will visit Notre Dame Cathedral, the Miraculous Medal and Green Scapular Shrine, Saint Vincent de Paul Shrine, the Louvre and D'Orsay Museums.

The authentic "Crown of Thorns" and a piece of the "True Cross" of Our Lord's Passion are kept in the Cathedral of Notre Dame having been given to the people of France by the Emperor Charlemagne. We will attend Holy Mass, celebrated by Father DiOrio, in the Basilica of Notre Dame, the Basilica of Sacre Cour, and in the chapel of the Miraculous Medal where the "Blessed Virgin Mary" gave the design of the medal to Sister St. Catherine Laboure in the year 1830 and the Green Scapular, in the same chapel, to a novice Nun ten years later. Each Mass will be followed by a teaching and healing session.

We move on to the famous Marian shrine at Lourdes, France where "Our Lady" appeared to Sister St. Bernadette and instructed her to dig in the dirt, in a nearby cave, when she did healing waters gushed out. Visit also St. Bernadette's childhood home and parish church. Pray in the Cave before the statue of Our Lady of Lourdes, which overlooks the healing waters on the grotto floor where St. Bernadette once knelt. Spend as much time as your wish in this sacred place for adoration, contemplation, and meditation.

The pilgrimage includes excursions from Paris to St. Therese's Shrine in Lisieux and St. Bernadette's Shrine in Nevers, France. St. Therese became known world wide as the "Little Flower". St. Bernadette's incorrupt body lies in the convent chapel of St. Gildard in Nevers. This chapel is in the convent where St. Bernadette lived out the remainder of her life. Lunch will be served here, in the convent dining room, by the Nuns.

Holy Mass will be celebrated every day, by Father DiOrio, followed by a teaching and healing session in the Basilicas, Cathedrals, Churches, and Shrines mentioned in the attached brochure/ flyer.

There is a great deal of interest, expressed to us while planning this pilgrimage, and we expect that it will be sold out very quickly. Both the airline(s) and our European suppliers have given us only a limited number of spaces. Therefore! If you are interested in joining this journey of faith we must have your Two Hundred (\$200.00) dollar deposit and the completed reservations form as soon as possible.
